GUIDELINES





PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- 1. All current, dues-paying members of ABA and a local regional independent booksellers association are eligible to participate in Independent Bookstore Day. Membership in both is required because Independent Bookstore Day is supported financially by ABA and the eight regional bookseller associations.
- 2. No orders of exclusives are necessary to participate. However, stores that wish to participate MUST SIGN UP to do so and must agree to celebrate in-store and/or online on Independent Bookstore Day. With or without exclusives, sign up to participate using the Independent Bookstore Day 2025 Participation and Exclusives Order Form to assure your store receives all Independent Bookstore Day information, marketing materials, and is included on the searchable map.
 - a. Deadline to order exclusives: November 8, 2024
 - b. Deadline to sign up to participate without ordering exclusives: March 31, 2025
- To carry the Independent Bookstore Day exclusives, place your order using the online form available October 11 by Friday, November 8. There is no minimum to participate, but Ingram's 20-item minimum for freebies and free shipping still applies.
- 4. Only stores that order exclusives are eligible to order the free items for giveaways.
- 5. Free items, Blackwing Pencils, and T-shirts **DO NOT** count toward the **20-item minimum** for free shipping. Without the 20 paid item minimum, stores will pay the \$6 flat rate shipping fee.

- 6. All orders are non-returnable and cannot be canceled after November 8. 2024.
- 7. All distribution and invoicing is through Ingram*. Stores must have an account in good standing. All items are non-returnable and include free freight if the minimum of 20 paid items has been met. Discounts of 45% apply to all Independent Bookstore Day items. *Blackwing Pencils will invoice and ship separately.
- 8. Exclusives will be shipped from Ingram's Tennessee warehouse early- to mid-April, 2025.
- 9. We want every store to be on a level playing field and for Independent Bookstore Day to be a single, nationwide event. To that end, you may list Independent Bookstore Day exclusives online, but items may not be held, reserved, or sold before April 26, 2025. T-shirts and tote bags are the only item that can be sold to your customers ahead of time to serve as marketing for Independent Bookstore Day.
- 10. Stores may continue to sell items in-store and online after Independent Bookstore Day. Please respect the publishers and writers who have supported indies by creating exclusive items for Independent Bookstore Day by NOT selling items on third-party websites such as eBay or AbeBooks.
- 11. Stores may display any and all Independent Bookstore Day items as soon as they are received! **T-shirts and tote bags are the only item that can be sold to your customers ahead of time** to serve as marketing for Independent Bookstore Day.







She is also editor of The Inside Light: New Critical Essays on Zora Neale Hurston, and the author of Zora Neale Hurston: A Biography of the Spirit and Every Tub Must Sit On Its Own Bottom: The Philosophy and Politics of Zora Neale Hurston. She holds MA and Ph. D. degrees in English from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.
